

ORDINANCE 24-06-04-001

Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program

WHEREAS, the Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program is believed to be beneficial to the local community; and

WHEREAS, private citizens may have an interest in contributing toward the Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide by way of ordinance for a special fund to enable private citizens to make contributions toward the Kosciusko County Community Recovery program;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Kosciusko County, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a special fund, to be designated and known as the "Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program Donation Fund." This fund shall be a continuing, non-reverting fund, with all balances remaining therein at the end of each year. Such balances shall not lapse into the county general fund, or ever be directly or indirectly diverted in any manner to uses other than those stated in this Section.

SECTION 2. All donations made to the Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program shall be deposited into the Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program Donation Fund.

SECTION 3. The fund shall be administered by the Kosciusko County Auditor and all donations deposited therein shall be used for the benefit of the Kosciusko County Community Recovery Program. Expenditures from this fund shall be made without appropriation.


SECTION 4. Annual financial reports shall be prepared by the Kosciusko County Auditor and reviewed by the Kosciusko County Board of Commissioners.



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
